**CARDBOARD
IS RECYCLABLE!**

Collect cardboard separately from other trash so that it can be picked up for recycle.

Boxes must be EMPTY—no bubble wrap or peanuts
(Scrape out foam packaging with a putty knife. Dispose foam in dumpster. Collect peanuts in plastic bags and return to stores, or dispose in dumpster.)

Boxes must be broken down—FLAT
PLEASE HELP US – BREAK DOWN BOXES

Cardboard from home can be recycled too! For a list of recycling centers near you, ask your ESH Officer.
