RENTAL TRUCKS

We are not allowed to rent trucks for company business unless:

1. THE RENTAL TRUCK IS UNDER 10,001 GROSS VEHICLE WEIGHT (GVW) RATING and
2. NO HAZARDOUS MATERIALS WILL BE TRANSPORTED IN THE TRUCK

The reasons we cannot rent trucks unless both of these requirements are met:

Vehicles over 10,001 GVW are classified by the Department of

Transportation as commercial vehicles and the drivers of such vehicles must be included in the ORNL driver program.

Vehicles transporting hazardous materials must be properly placarded. Hazardous material must be properly packaged and labeled. Shipping papers must be prepared for all hazardous material shipments.

A commercial drivers license (CDL) is required when driving a vehicle over 26,001 GVW.
